VI. <u>COMMITTEE REPORTS</u>

A. <u>Academic and Student Affairs</u> (L. Ghartey, Chair)

1. <u>Approval of College's Slogan, Mission, Core Values, Lenses and</u> Institutional Goals (Res. #2023-16)

The College has developed a Strategic Plan with input from various internal and external stakeholder groups. After reviewing the plan, the Board of Trustees endorses and approves the Slogan, Mission, Core Values, Lenses, and Institutional Goals as outlined in the plan.

C. Finance and Facilities

1. Approval of Bid for Mechatronics & HVAC Labs (Res. #2023-17)

Bids were solicited for the construction of the Mechatronics and HVAC laboratories at DCC Fishkill. Two bids were received, with only one meeting specifications. PVS Construction meets all of the specifications and the bid price is within budget. Capital funding is available to pay for this project. It is recommended that **PVS Construction** be awarded the contract **in the amount of \$287,700**.

D. Personnel and Community Relations

1. Approval of Professional Staff Titles (Res. #2023-18)

Section 35 of the New York State Civil Service law requires that the initial determination of titles in the Professional Service be made by the College Board of Trustees. Titles are then submitted to the State University of New York (SUNY). Based upon a review of the needs of the College, it is recommended that the Board approve the following three titles: 1) ESL (English as a Second Language) Professional Tutor (part-time), 2) Reading and Literacy Professional Tutor (part-time), and 3) Tutoring Coordinator (full-time).

2. Approval of Tenure (Res. #2023-19)

The following two faculty members are recommended for tenure, to be effective September 1, 2023: **Mariana Melo**, Assistant Professor, Department of Allied Health & Biological Sciences, and **Nancy Perretta**, Instructor, Department of Allied Health & Biological Sciences.
