VIII. COMMITTEE REPORTS

A. Finance and Facilities (S. Appel, Chair)

1. Approval of Capital Projects:

a. FF&E and Technology Replacements and Upgrades (Res. #2022-01)

This capital project is needed to ensure that the campus stays up-todate with technology and laboratory facilities, as well as to maintain and replace classroom and office furniture and plant operations equipment.

The total estimated cost of the project is \$200,000. The sponsor's share of the project (\$100,000) will be funded through Capital Chargeback Funds.

b. Campus Site Repairs and Upgrades – Phase 2 (Res. #2022-02)

Various stairs, sidewalks and walkways around campus are in need of repair or replacement. This capital project includes the necessary repairs and upgrades to eliminate potentially dangerous situations.

The total estimated cost of the project is \$1,500,000. The sponsor's share (\$750,000) will be bonded in accordance with SUNY funding policy and procedures for capital projects.

c. Plumbing and Utility Repairs (Res. #2022-03)

This capital project will replace the underground heating and cooling water piping running between Hudson Hall and the Washington Center. Additional necessary plumbing and utility repairs as identified in the Facilities Master Plan will also be included as part of this project

The estimated cost of this project is \$1,000,000. The sponsor's share (\$500,000) will be bonded in accordance with SUNY funding policy and procedures for capital projects.

B. <u>Personnel and Community Relations</u> (A. Flesland, Chair)

1. Approval of Professional Staff Titles (Res. #2022-04)

Section 35 of the New York State Civil Service law requires that the initial determination of titles in the Professional Service be made by the

College Board of Trustees. Titles are then submitted to the Office of the Chancellor of the State University of New York. Based upon the changes in the College's counseling and health care areas, it has been determined that two new titles need to be created to accurately reflect the responsibilities of these offices. It is recommended that the Board of Trustees classify and create the following titles according to current conditions: **Director of Mental and Physical Health Services** and **Coordinator of Health Services**. Once approved, these titles will be forwarded to SUNY.

2. Professional Staff Appointment (Res. #2022-05)

Debra Brooks-Leyden is recommended for a temporary, full-time appointment as Instructor of Nursing for the 2021-2022 academic year at an annual salary of \$69,965. Ms. Brooks-Leyden received two Associate degrees from Daytona State College and a B.S. and M.S. in Nursing from the University of Central Florida. In addition to her experience as an educator, she has extensive experience as a Perioperative and Staff Nurse.
