# Dear Friends and Alumni

The past 12 months was an exciting time on campus as Dutchess Community College celebrated its 50th Anniversary, enrolled the largest class in our history, and had the pleasure to recognize our first \$1 million lifetime donor.

The College celebrated its 50th anniversary with numerous events: lectures, seminars, theatrical productions, two festive galas, a '50s Sock Hop, a culminating fireworks display, and much more. A generous grant from the Dyson Foundation allowed us to complete a socio-economic impact study that highlighted how important to our area Dutchess Community College is now and has been in the past. The study concluded that the College has had a beneficial impact on Dutchess County and New York State, and that public support of Dutchess Community College is an investment rather than a cost.

The creation of Dutchess Community College 50 years ago was achieved by the commitment and hard work of many dedicated and visionary residents who saw the need for an affordable and accessible educational institution in Dutchess County. Community colleges as a whole were relatively new 50 years ago: there were only 40 in the country at that time. Since that day in September 1958 when the College welcomed its first incoming class of 674 full- and part-time students, almost 40,000 students have graduated and countless others have taken advantage of the College's numerous offerings - from academic programs to one-year vocational certificates, and from workforce training to GED classes. I'm sure many of you reading this report today count yourselves among that number.

The fall 2007 semester saw the largest incoming class in the College's history - 8,540 students. Selecting DCC as the starting point for a college education has become a very popular choice for the resi-

dents of Dutchess County as people recognize the value of a DCC education. The College has, in fact, become the college of choice for County residents. More than one-third of all students in the county who go to college attend Dutchess Community College. This figure is an affirmation of the quality of the affordable, accessible education that we offer.

Another major event of which we are proud and grateful is that Llelanie Orcutt became our first lifetime \$1 million donor. We are honored that Mrs. Orcutt has been a friend and supporter of the College for many years. Her husband, Jack, was one of the College's founding faculty members and the first director of student activities. The DCC Foundation holds a golf tournament annually in his honor.

Dutchess Community College is proud of its mission of providing affordable, accessible, and excellent education and service. As we pause each year to assess our performance, we are reminded of, and grateful for, the support we receive from you, our graduates and friends. Without your support, we would not succeed as well as we do in fulfilling our mission.

Thank you again for supporting Dutchess Community College and the Foundation. I look forward to seeing you at one of the many special and cultural events held at the College throughout the coming year.

# Happy Anniversary Dutchess!

Last year was a busy one at DCC as the College celebrated 50 years of excellence and service to the residents of Dutchess County and the mid-Hudson Valley. Our year-long celebration culminated with a Gala Dinner Dance at the Grandview in Poughkeepsie with 500 of our closest friends. Having the community come together in such a big way demonstrates the amazing support the College enjoys locally. He retired as Chief of Police for the City of Beacon after 33 years of service, where he worked his way up through the ranks and served in various special capacities including being one of the original K-9 officers for the City of Beacon. He was also instrumental in obtaining a police motorcycle for Beacon (a Harley of course). Rich was a past president of the Dutchess County Police Chiefs Association and the current president of the New York State Retired Chiefs Benevolent Association. Rich was a co-founder of the New York State Crimestoppers. He was a fifth-degree black belt in the World Tae Kwan Do Association and an instructor with Beacon Recreation. Previously he was a member of the Elks Club, Lions Club, Southern Dutchess Exchange Club, and Beacon Volunteer Ambulance Corps. He was an avid Harley rider, skier (both downhill and cross country), snowshoer, golfer, pianist, and Corvette enthusiast. He loved spending time with his family, dog Ace, and special friends. He was enjoying selling cars at Healey Hyundai in Beacon. He loved learning everything he could about the Hyundai line and it showed in his sales accomplishments. ## 'Incredible Marine' is laid to rest

Trevor Yurista, a Pleasant Valley native and a 1st lieutenant with the U.S. Marines, died Oct. 27. He was killed when an improvised explosive device detonated while he was on duty in Afghanistan's Helmand province, near the border of Pakistan. He was 32.

Yurista was a graduate of Arlington High School and attended Dutchess Community College and John Jay College of Criminal Justice. He graduated from the U.S. Marine Corps officer candidates school in Virginia in 2005 and had been based in San Diego. He worked as a ground intelligence officer in Afghanistan and in Iraq, where he served two previous tours.

### 'Outpouring of Love'

"The community and the Marines have been absolutely wonderful," said Heather Sekunda, Yurista's sister. "There was an outpouring of love and support from family and friends as well as the Marine Corps, both in California and locally. We are incredibly proud of my brother. He was an incredible person and an incredible Marine."

Yurista is the second local man to have been killed in Afghanistan in the past two months and the third in the past year. Second Lt. Mohsin Naqvi, a Newburgh native, was killed in September and Spc. Mark Palmateer, a Poughkeepsie resident, was killed in June.

Curtis Moore, a former Arlington school district principal who knew Yurista through middle and high schools, said he was overwhelmed by the number of Marines who knew him and spoke during Monday's funeral.

"Trevor is truly an unforgettable person who had an effect on everyone he came into contact with and today's (Monday's) services confirmed that," Moore said. "Trevor was a dedicated and caring leader who acted out of concern for our country and our American way of life."

## DCC Business Department Plaza Dedicated in Honor of First Department Head

The Business Department Plaza outside Dutchess Community College's Taconic Hall was dedicated in honor of Anthony Krzywicki, the first head of DCC's Business Department, on May 8, 2008.

Krzywicki, who came to DCC in 1958 to run the business department and develop the college bookstore, was one of the College's founding faculty members. In 1959 he became the first head of the department. He is credited with developing



the first business programs at DCC, as well as teaching most of the early courses in general business, retailing, and secretarial science. He retired in 1986. Krzywicki has a master's degree in Business Education from Columbia University, and was formerly a professor at Bucknell University where he earned his bachelor's degree.

## DCC President Inducted into New York Business Hall of Fame

Dr. D. David Conklin, president of Dutchess Community College and member of the Dutchess County Economic Development Corporation (DCEDC) board of directors, is one of two individuals, along with a business, who have been inducted into the New York Business Hall of Fame as the Class of 2007.

Dr. Conklin was recognized in July of last year by the organization for his long record of successful management, expertise, and business skills along with his many notable achievements while president of DCC.



During Dr. Conklin's tenure at the College, 18 new academic programs have been added to the curriculum, an endowed faculty chair initiative was created to allow faculty members to further pursue excellence in education, a mini-grant program was established to fund special faculty and staff projects, and an honors convocation was started to recognize student academic achievement and award scholarships. In addition, the DCC Foundation began a 15-year period of sustained growth under Dr. Conklin's leadership, and in 2007 reported more than \$5 million in assets, a huge jump in funds from the \$280,069 on hand in 1992 when Dr. Conklin assumed leadership of the College.

In 2008, DCC reported its highest enrollment in its 50-year history, and Dr. Conklin's induction honors his integral role not only in that achievement, but the many others over his 15-year presidency.

Also key to the College's increase in enrollment over the years is the physical expansion of the campus. Since Dr. Conklin became president, major work took place including the building of the Allyn J. Washington Center for Science and Art, the creation of the new Francis U. and Mary F. Ritz Library inside Hudson Hall, the remodeling of the former library building into the Jack and Llelanie Orcutt Student Services Center, and the remodeling of the student lounge in Dutchess Hall.

Dr. Conklin also chairs the Empire Zone Administrative Board, a vital part of the DCEDC, an entity that aims to attract new businesses to Dutchess County while helping to retain and expand the business currently in the county. The Empire Zone encourages new investment in designated areas through tax advantages and other incentives.

"He's been an outstanding chairman of the Empire Zone Administrative Board," said Anne Conroy, executive director of the DCEDC. "He has led the board to enable assistance for 300 businesses, employing approximately 16,500 people, and to invest more than \$5 billion since he became chairman, which is a tremendous accomplishment."

The New York Business Hall of Fame was established in 2006, and showcases successful companies and business leaders through networking and industry events held throughout the state. The organization partners with private and public organizations, corporations and associations to promote economic development and new ideas in the marketplace.

## 'Philadelphia' Screenwriter Speaks at DCC

Ron Nyswaner, award-winning screenwriter of "Soldier's Girl" and "Philadelphia," gave a presentation at Dutchess Community College on October 20.

During his lecture, which was free and open to the public, Nyswaner showed clips from some of his films while discussing writing and the arts.

In addition to "Soldier's Girl" and "Philadelphia," Nyswaner wrote the screenplays for other films such as "Mrs. Soffel," "Painted Veil," "Love Hurts," "The Prince of Pennsylvania," "Smithereens," and co-authored "Gross Anatomy."

"Philadelphia" won two Academy Awards, and earned Nyswaner a Golden Globe nomination, a Writers' Guild award nomination, a British Academy of Film and Television Arts (BAFTA) award nomination, and an Academy Award nomination. "Soldier's Girl" premiered at the 2003 Sundance Film Festival and received the Peabody Award, three Golden Globe nominations, an Emmy nomination, a Television Critics Association nomination, a Gotham Award, and was named by the American Film Institute as one of the 10 outstanding television events of the year.

Nyswaner's lecture was presented by Joseph Cosentino, holder of the Llelanie Orcutt Endowed Chair, and head of the Department of Performing, Visual Arts and Communications. The Llelanie Orcutt Endowed Chair is made possible by a generous donation from Llelanie Orcutt.

### Past DCC Lyceum Speaker Wins Nobel Prize

Paul Krugman, who won the Nobel Prize this past year, spoke to more than 500 people at Dutchess Community College on March 29, 2007 discussing the current healthcare debate, comparing plans presented by the governors of California and Massachusetts, and health plans of other nations. He was invited to campus by economics professor Seemi Ahmad.

Professor Ahmad is the recipient of the Dutchess Community College Handel Family Endowed Faculty Chair. The Chair was established in 2003 by the Handel

Family to honor the memory of Franklin and Eleanor Roosevelt.

Princeton University Scholar and New York Times columnist Dr. Paul Krugman, won the Nobel economic prize for his analysis of how economies of scale impact the location of economic activity and trade patterns.

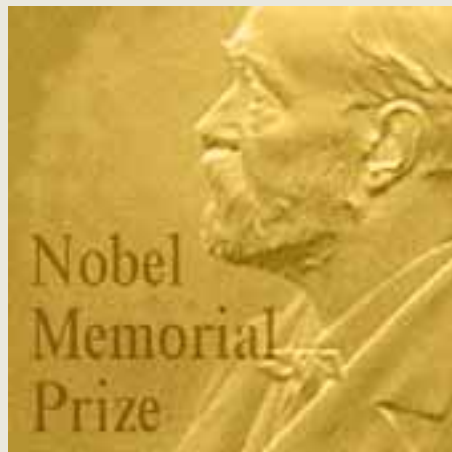
"Dr. Krugman's work on international trade is well known in academia," said Professor Ahmad. "People familiar with his New York Times columns know that he can explain complex issues in an easy-to-understand way."

Friend and longtime supporter of the College, Bernard Handel, who endowed the Handel Family Endowed Faculty Chair, had praise for Krugman.

"He's had a marvelous career as an economist and as a columnist for the New York Times," said Handel. "His judgment on economic matters and the gains and problems of active foreign commerce interchange are excellent and he is more than deserving of this award. I'm pleased that DCC was able to welcome someone of his caliber to campus as the speaker at the Handel Family Endowed Professor lecture. We again thank Professor Seemi Ahmad for helping to bring Dr. Krugman. We are very proud that our speaker has won the Nobel Prize."

Dr. Krugman met with economics students prior to the lecture.

The Nobel Memorial Prize in Economic Sciences comes with a monetary award of \$1.4



million. The Swedish Central Bank created the award in Alfred Nobel's memory in 1968. It is not one of the original Nobels, which were established in 1901 to honor achievements in physics, chemistry, medicine, literature, and peace.



### DCC Student-Produced TV Show Team Travels to Washington, D.C. to Cover Obama Inauguration

Eighteen student producers from Dutchess Community College's Communications program joined the thousands of media professionals covering January's presidential inauguration. Four of the students received press credentials giving them the same access as any member of a national news outlet.

The DCC students, all participants in "Learning in Progress," a student-produced TV program, regularly produce the show as part of two communications classes taught by Professor Camilo Rojas. The show covers a wide variety of topics, and has received numerous awards.

In addition to covering the inauguration itself, the students interviewed visitors to Washington, D.C. who came to witness the swearing-in of President Barack Obama. Their taped interviews and film of the ceremony will be used in the "Learning in Progress" series.



# IRA Giving

Between now and December 31, 2009, IRA owners age 70½ and older may take advantage of the IRA charitable rollover provision. This provision allows U.S. taxpayers to make tax-free distributions of up to \$100,000 in 2009 from an IRA to qualified charitable organizations, such as the Dutchess Community College Foundation. Charitable distributions from an IRA can be used to satisfy the annual required minimum distribution (RMD).

Remember, IRA assets left to heirs may be subject to estate and income taxes, so this is a unique opportunity to avoid both taxes.

## How to Qualify:

- Distributions may be made in 2009
- Donors must be age 70½ or older on the date of the distribution
- Distribute, to qualified charities such as the Dutchess Community College Foundation, up to \$100,000 per taxpayer, per year (Couples with separate IRAs can each gift up to \$100,000 per year)
- Distributions to charity can be applied to satisfy required minimum distribution (RMD)
- Distribution must be transmitted directly from your IRA's plan administrator to the charity
- Receipt from the charity is required for a donor to substantiate a charitable IRA distribution
- This opportunity does not apply to other forms of retirement plans such as 401(k), 403(b), etc.

## Making the Gift is Easy:

Direct your IRA manager to distribute funds directly to the Dutchess Community College Foundation. To designate your distribution to a particular fund, instruct your IRA manager to make the distribution payable to the "Dutchess Community College Foundation - Name of the Fund ". To ensure you receive proper acknowledgement for your contribution, be sure to share your intentions with the DCC Foundation, Office of Institutional Advancement, 845-431-8400.

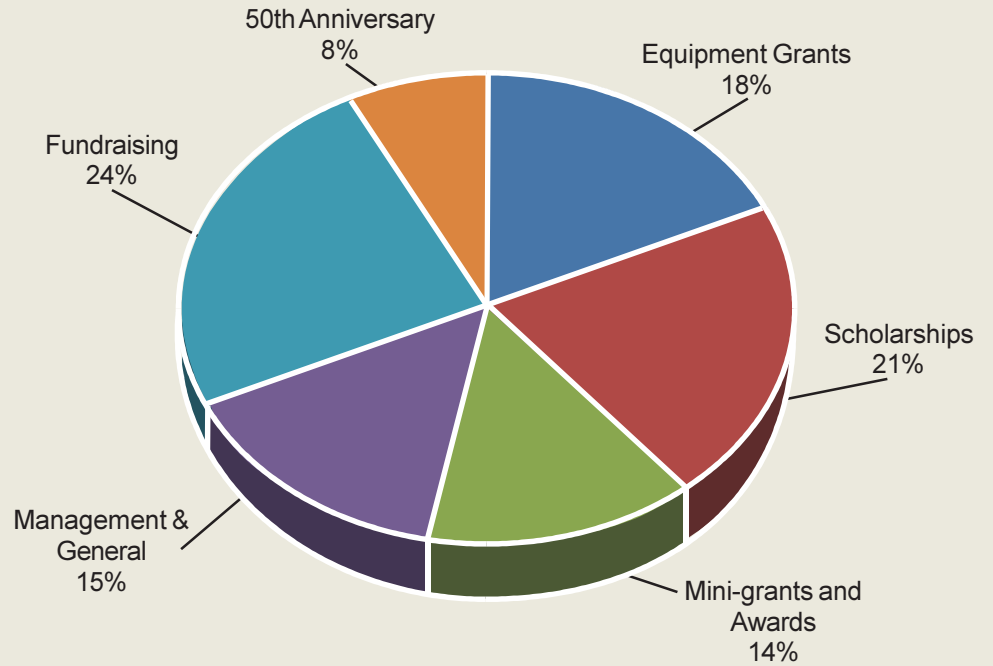

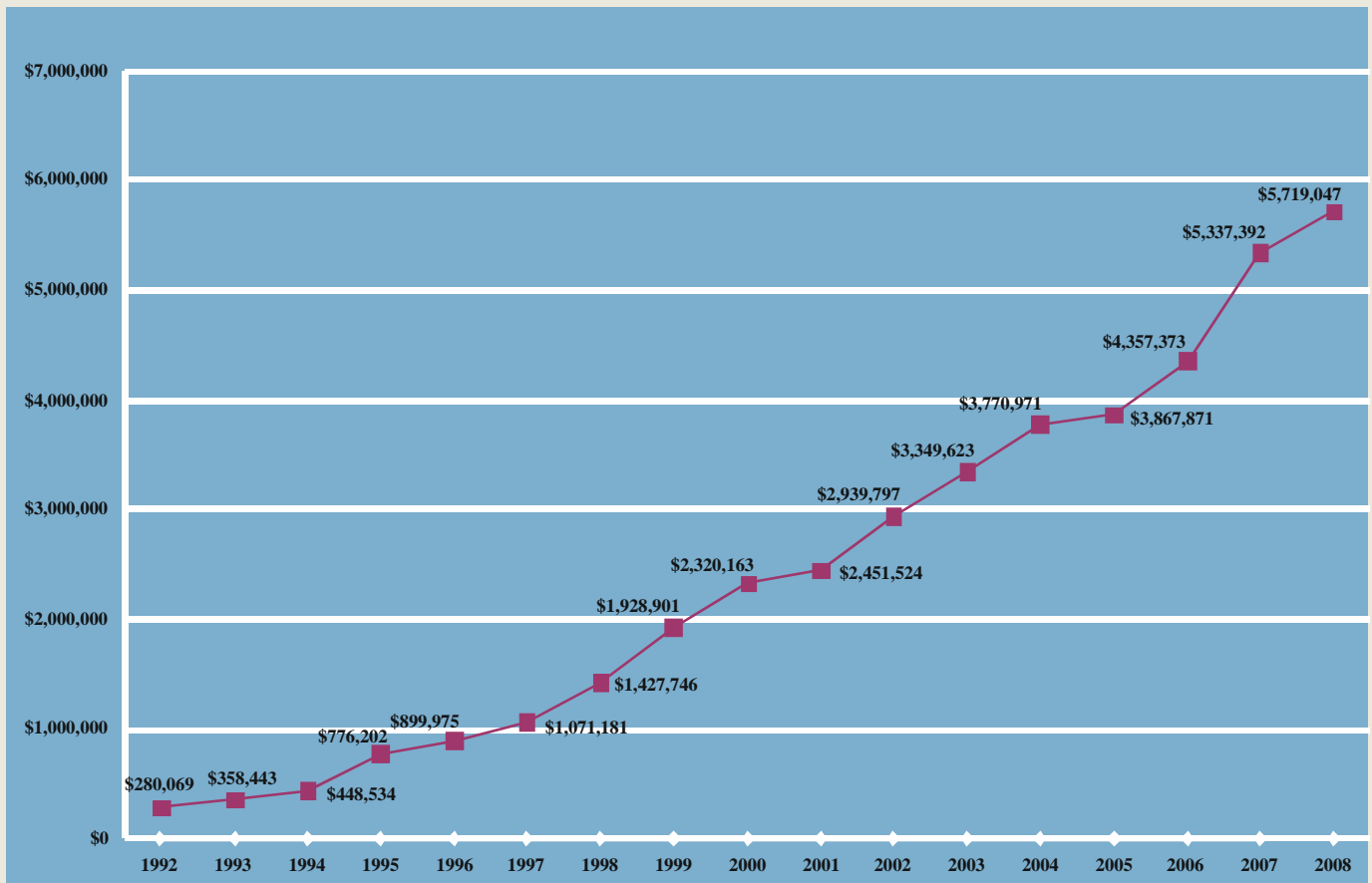
