We provide a Developmentally Appropriate Program to help each child meet his or her fullest potential intellectually, socially, emotionally and physically. At our school, children have many real choices. We support engagement through hands-on activities and investigative projects. We value consistency for children We help children develop confidence, trust and independence through a familiar routine and consistent guidance.
