Students interested in combining the quality, affordability and other benefits of a Dutchess Community College education with the experience of living away at college will be able to do so beginning in fall 2012, when DCC will offer on-campus housing for the first time.

The fully furnished, suite-style units are designed for comfort, safety and convenience, and the building's residence-life staff, amenities and programs will combine to create a welcoming environment that enriches the student experience.

The new residence hall features:

- Convenient location near academic buildings, campus activities, sporting events and student services
- 465 beds configured in two-, four-, five- and six-person suites
- Lounge on each floor
- Multi-purpose atrium
- Wireless Internet and cable television service
- Laundry, fitness and mail rooms
- Vending area
- Noncombustible construction
- Sprinklers throughout
- 24-hour security
- Central entrance and exit
- Controlled access
- On-site resident director and resident advisors

Spacious, comfortable suite-style living options:



- **Six-person suite** (48 available) - 1,243 square feet
 - Three double bedrooms, two bathrooms
 - Kitchenette with refrigerator, microwave and sink
 - Living room
- Double room - \$3,150 per semester



- **Four-person suite** (22 available) - 962 square feet
 - Two double bedrooms, two bathrooms
 - Kitchenette with refrigerator, microwave and sink
 - Living room
- Double room - \$3,300 per semester



- **Five-person suite** (15 available) - 1,229 square feet
 - Two double bedrooms, one single bedroom, two bathrooms
 - Kitchenette with refrigerator, microwave and sink
 - Living room
- Double room - \$3,150 per semester • Single room - \$3,450 per semester



- **Two-person suite** (6 available) - 607 square feet
 - Two single bedrooms, one bathroom
 - Kitchenette with refrigerator, microwave and sink
- Single room - \$3,450 per semester

Please note: Cost is per student, per semester. The housing contract will cover the full academic year, but for the convenience of students and their families, housing will be billed on a per-semester basis.



Dining

All students living in the residence hall must choose a meal plan. Our dining services provider – a worldwide firm that serves some of our area's leading local private and public colleges – offers five options (\$890 to \$1,300 per semester) to meet every need.
