

Articulation Agreement

Programs:	Associate in Applied Science (AAS) Nursing	and	Bachelor of Science (BS) Nursing

PURPOSE

This document establishes a transfer articulation agreement between Dutchess Community College (DCC), located in Poughkeepsie, NY and Alfred State College (ASC), located in Alfred, NY. Its purpose is to afford DCC students the opportunity to pre-plan their college careers and to facilitate the transfer process for graduates of DCC's Associate in Applied Science (AAS) Nursing program to the Bachelor of Science (BS) Nursing program at ASC.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION AND STANDING

Admission to the BS Nursing program requires graduation from an associate degree nursing program and plans to secure licensure as a Registered Nurse (RN) by the end of the first semester after matriculating at ASC. The minimum DCC cumulative grade point average (GPA) requirement for admission is 2.00. The applicant's coursework will include at least 33 credits of nursing, 30 credits in liberal arts and sciences, eight credits of anatomy and physiology, a lab-based course in microbiology, and coursework in written communication, literature, psychology, and sociology. Additionally, a minimum of three SUNY General Education categories must be satisfied.

Students who meet the requirements stated above are guaranteed admission into the BS Nursing program at ASC with full junior status. Students who do not meet all of the above criteria will be evaluated for acceptance on a case by case basis.

GENERAL GUARANTEE OF OPPORTUNITY TO GRADUATE

For fall admits, students who graduate from DCC with an AAS Nursing, and who have met all acceptance criteria as specific in Appendix A, are guaranteed the opportunity to earn the BS Nursing with four additional semesters of normal coursework through ASC.

TRANSFER AND GRADUATION INFORMATION

The BS in Nursing at ASC is an upper division completion program. Upon meeting acceptance criteria, students can transfer additional lower-level DCC credits toward BS in Nursing requirements.

All candidates for the BS in Nursing degree must complete 30 upper division credits through ASC. See the appendix for a detailed overview of acceptance criteria and required subsequent academic coursework.

ASC accepts transfer credit only, not course grades. Grades must be "C" or better to transfer.

Graduation requirements to receive the BS in Nursing include:

28 credits of upper-level nursing

A minimum of 60 credits of liberal arts and sciences (inclusive of associate degree credits)

A minimum of a "C" grade in upper-level nursing courses

PROMOTION OF AGREEMENT

Both parties have the right to use this agreement and the names of Dutchess Community College and Alfred State College in all promotional activities and print products, including college catalogs and recruitment or advisement materials.

PROVISION FOR CHANGES IN POLICIES OR CURRICULA

Proposed changes in policies or curricula by either party should be communicated in writing to the other party.

IMPLEMENTATION

ASC will provide to DCC students accepted under this agreement an outline of their individual requirements for completion of the BS Nursing and all advisement and support services normally available to matriculated students.

ASC will be entirely responsible for all aspects of student enrollment once the student is accepted and enrolled, and appropriate academic personnel at ASC will convey information about the opportunities provided through this agreement.

FINANCIAL AID AND TUITION

Students accepted into ASC under this agreement are eligible to participate in all ASC sponsored financial aid, grants, assistantships, and scholarship programs customarily open to transfer students.

LOCATION / DELIVERY MODE


Alfred State's BS in Nursing program is designed to be taken entirely online. An online orientation course must be completed prior to taking any online course work.

EFFECTIVE DATE AND PROVISION FOR CANCELLATION

This agreement becomes effective on the latest date of signature on the agreement signature page and shall be in effect for three (3) years. Changes in any of the curricula by either party will necessitate a review and modification of the agreement. Either party may independently cancel this agreement by notifying the other party in writing no less than one year before the intended date of cancellation.




