(4)Select from: ATHR 101, ATHR 102, ATHR 201, ATHR 202, ATHR 301, ATHR 302. Only 3 credits may be acting practicum and a maximum of 3 credits from ATHR 102, ATHR 202, and ATHR 302 combined.
(5)Select one course from each group:
• Group A: ATHR 339, ATHR 340, or ATHR 343
• Group B: ATHR 314, ATHR 335, ATHR 360, ATHR 370, or ATHR 381
• Group C: ATHR 309, ATHR 319, ATHR 361, ATHR 380, ATHR 421, or ATHR 356
(6)Select one course from: ATHR 450, ATHR 460, ATHR 475, ATHR 481, or ATHR 499.
