- ³ A business elective (U/L) is an elective from Business school upper division courses.

- ⁵ Physics or Chemistry Electives can be chosen from PHYS 121 & 125, PHYS 122 & 126, PHYS 131 & 135, PHYS 132 & 136, CHEM 150, CHEM 155, or equivalent.
