PAYMENT

There are two convenient ways to make your tuition payment:

- 1) Please go to www.sunydutchess.edu/paynow. You will be directed to log into your MyDCC. Then click "View and Pay Accounts" on the left hand side; this is where you can pay your balance due in full. If you would like to sign up for our automatic withdrawal payment plan, please click "Payment Plan" on the left hand side. TO ADD OR DROP COURSES

If you need to add or drop courses before the start of the semester, you can do so through your MyDCC using the six digit PIN you received during your initial advising session. If you have questions about adding or dropping, you can reach out to the Academic, Career, and Transfer Center (ACT) during regular business hours: Monday through Thursday 8:30a.m. to 3:30 p.m., and Friday 10:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Students who wish to make schedule changes may use web registration www.mysunydutchess.edu (myDCC) to add or drop courses through January 26, 2024. Students should not appeal to instructors to enroll in classes. The last day to Withdraw from a Spring session course is April 11, 2024. You can email registrar@sunydutchess.edu prior to that day from your DCC email if you wish to withdraw.

PLACEMENT TESTING

If you plan to enroll in an English or Math course, you may need to take a placement test if you have not fulfilled the course prerequisites. The Testing Center hours can be viewed on the web at www.sunydutchess.edu/testing. If you are unsure if you have met the course prerequisites, please visit your Application Status Portal at connect.sunydutchess.edu/account/login. Log in using the credentials you created when you applied. Students who need accommodations for the placement test should submit documentation to the Office of Accommodative Services at www.sunydutchess.edu/oas (845) 431-8055, and schedule their placement test with the Testing Center atention for accommodations. Students who opt to take the placement test without accommodations are not eligible to re-test with accommodations.
