Immunization Requirements PHL 2165:

To protect the health and well-being of the campus community, students are required to have immunization information on file with College Health Office. **Any student born on or after January 1, 1957 who is taking six or more credit hours is required by New York State to provide proof of immunity to Measles, Mumps and Rubella.** Proof can be obtained through valid immunizations and positive blood titers. A physician can verify a history of Measles or Mumps. Medical and religious exemptions must provide physician or religious documentation.

Meningitis Requirements PHL 2167:

Students in New York State are not required to have a meningitis immunization to attend college, but they must have a signed Meningitis Response Form on file in the College Health Office.
